Description:

The Department of English invites applications for an Assistant Professor. This is a full-time one year term contract position that will begin in August 2019 with a 4/4 teaching load and has the possibility of renewal.

The successful candidate will:

- Teach a variety of writing courses in the English curriculum, serving not only undergraduate English majors and minors, but also K-12 English Language Arts teacher education students, and students across all disciplines.
- Create course syllabi, develop instructional materials, and contribute to developing an innovative English curriculum.
- Participate in professional development as appropriate to the discipline, including publication, conferences, and other professional development activities, as well as provide service to the department and institution.
- Advise students.

Minimum Requirements:

- PhD in Rhetoric, Composition, Literacy Studies, or related field.
- Demonstrated ability to teach a variety of undergraduate writing courses.
- Evidence of ability to develop new courses to suit changing 21st century literacy needs.

Desired Qualifications:

- Evidence of ability to adapt to a wide variety of student needs and diverse populations.
- Evidence of ability to teach digital writing/literacies and creative writing.
- Evidence of ability to innovate and work collegially, creatively, and flexibly.
- Experience teaching at the collegiate level in a small liberal arts environment.
- Strong time management/organizational skills.
