**Description:**

The Department of Modern Languages & Cultures invites applications for an Assistant Professor of Spanish, with a specialization in one or more of the following areas: Contemporary Latin America, Hispanic Film, Cultural Film, Cultural Studies, US Latino Literature, Language Acquisition and Pedagogy. This is a full-time one year term contract position with a teaching load of 12 credits per semester. It will begin in August 2019 and has the possibility of renewal.

This position involves frequent verbal, written and email correspondence with students and department faculty members. The successful candidate will:

- Instruct Spanish undergraduate courses at a variety of levels, serving majors and minors and students from other disciplines
- Create course syllabi, develop instructional materials, and contribute to developing an innovative Spanish curriculum
- Participate in professional development as appropriate to the discipline, including publication, conferences, and other professional development activities, as well as provide service to the department and institution
- Advise and mentor undergraduate students
- Contribute to program expansion/departmental engagements, and extracurricular activities

**Minimum Requirements:**

- PhD in Spanish or related field
- Native or near-native fluency in both Spanish and English
- Demonstrated ability to teach a variety of undergraduate Spanish courses

**Desired Qualifications:**

- Evidence of ability to adapt to a wide variety of student needs and diverse populations
- Evidence of ability to innovate and work collegially, creatively, and flexibly
- An inquisitive scholar with a proven record of innovative undergraduate teaching at a growing liberal arts college
- Strong time management/organizational skills
