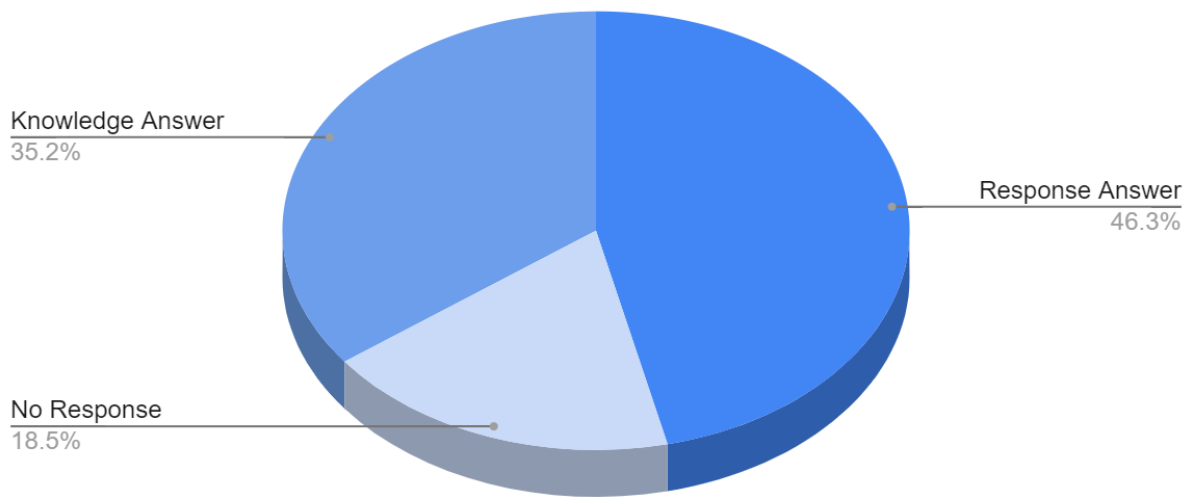

I. Introduction

In order to determine career location statistics for the 2017-2018 graduating class of Adrian College, graduates were given an exit survey upon graduation. Efforts were made to gain results for all graduates. A response answer came directly from the student, where the knowledge answer was learned through other sources (LinkedIn, faculty or staff member, etc.)

Answer Acquisition Method



In all, career information was obtained for 81.5% of graduates.

The remaining 18.5% were either unable to be located or did not respond to requests for information.

In this report, any graduate for whom career information was collected will be referred to as a “respondent”. **The following report is based on the 81.5% response rate.**

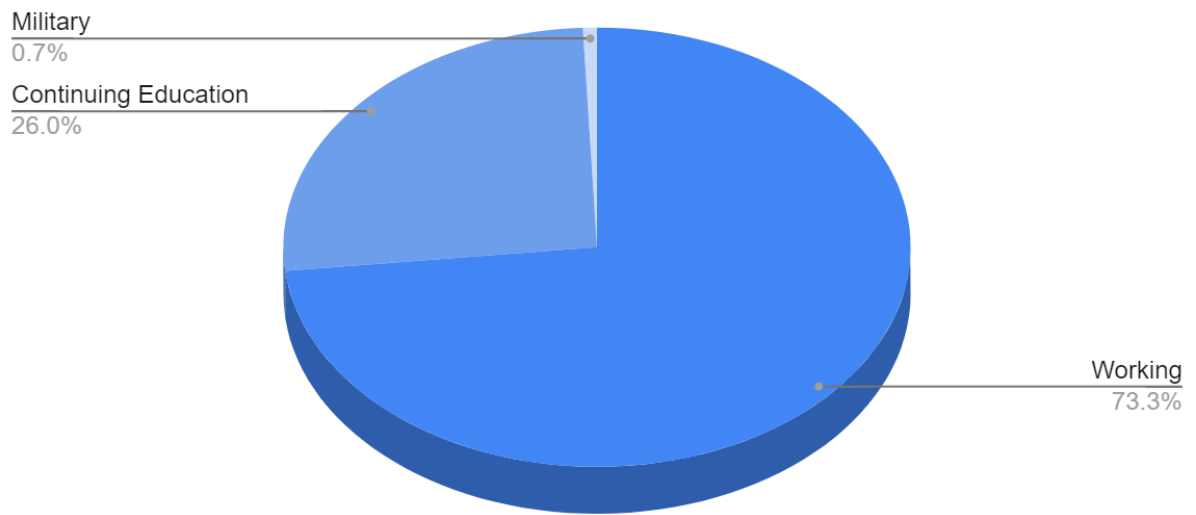
II. Employment and Graduate Educational Status

100% of respondents are either employed (full/part-time, temporary, or military) or in graduate school (277/277)

26% (72/277) of respondents are currently continuing their education or seeking additional career training/certification.

74% of respondents are currently employed (205/277)
