Position Title:	Assistant Athletic Trainer
Purpose of Position:	Assist in all aspects of athletic training
Classification:	Intern
Education:	Bachelor's Degree required

Example of Duties:

This position involves frequent verbal, written, and email correspondence with students, parents, faculty and staff. The successful candidate will:

- Coordinate and deliver athletic training services for student athletes involved in Adrian's 44 sport program
- Evaluate and treat injuries at practices and games
- Design and supervise rehabilitation programs
- Administer athletic training operations as assigned
- Adhere to all NCAA Division III and MIAA rules and regulations
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Minimum requirements:

- Bachelor's Degree in Athletic Training or a related field
- NATABOC certified
- Current CPR and AED certification
- Must be able to perform duties within the normal bounds of an office environment as well as stand for long periods of time and be exposed to a variety of weather conditions. Must also be able to bend, squat, kneel and demonstrate a variety of physical therapy techniques to student athletes.

The requirements listed above are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.

Desired Qualifications:

Previous experience working as a trainer at the collegiate level is preferred. The successful candidate will be a self-starter who is able to work independently, has excellent organizational, interpersonal and communication skills and will be someone who is able to interpret, apply and comply with all NCAA and MIAA rules and regulations.
