Job Description**

Qualifications:

- Sophomore, junior or senior as of the fall 2017 semester
- Knowledge of Adrian College, reliable, and effective interpersonal skills
- Candidates must be at ease working with groups of students
- Candidates must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.30 and be returning for the 2017 fall semester

Contract dates: August 9 through August 20, 2017

Compensation: \$200.00 paid during the fall semester, room and board during training and welcome week

Position: Up to 30 student leaders facilitating a group of 18-20 students

The purpose of welcome week is to help new students adjust to college life by forming supportive groups with their peers. During welcome week, student leaders serve as group facilitators for the program, and help incoming students make a successful transition to the academic and social climate of Adrian College.

Specific duties include:

Before Welcome Week

- Attend an information session with other welcome week leaders during the spring semester.
- Participate in welcome week leader training starting on Wednesday, August 9 through Saturday, August 12, 2017.

During Welcome Week (Sunday, August 13 - Sunday, August 20, 2017)

- Stay with your group during meals, evening activities, community service events, and other designated activities
- Listen and advise individual students in their groups
- Lead activities with your group and facilitate discussion
- Remind students to attend required activities
- Accompany students on the incoming class trip to Chicago
- Give assistance to the program, as needed (driving vans, giving directions, and welcoming students to residence halls)
- Provide a positive welcome and support to new students
