**Students are responsible for knowing, understanding, and implementing graduation requirements at Adrian College. Your academic advisor will assist you in facilitating this process.*

General Graduation Guidelines

- Total of 124 semester hours, 30 of which must be numbered 300 or 400
- Five – 3 or 4 credit courses meeting distribution requirements.
 - 1 of each: Arts, Humanities, Philosophy and Religion, Social Science, Natural Science
- At least one course designated as Non-Western.
- Basic educational proficiency requirements of 20 semester hours.
 - Academic Foundations I (CORE101; 3 hours), Academic Foundations II (CORE102; 3 hours), Language Skills (8 hours), Fitness/Wellness Skills (ESAT 100), Mathematical Skills (MATH 100 or MATH 101)
- A sophomore-level writing intensive course.
- A graduation major.
- A cumulative GPA average of C (2.00) and at least a C average in the graduation major, not counting cognate courses; a C average is also required in any minors which a student may elect.
- **The last 31 semester hours must be earned at Adrian College or in programs approved by the College.**

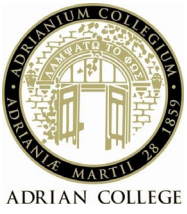
